# Super Specialized New Born Care Unit - NICU Level 2

Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU), a place of extraordinary care and hope for our tiniest patients and their families.

### What is Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU)?



Our NICU is a haven of specialized care for newborns that need extra support due to premature birth, low birth weight, congenital conditions, or other health challenges. Here, every baby receives individualized attention and the highest level of medical expertise.

### **State-of-the-Art Facilities**

Equipped with state-of-the-art technology and monitoring systems, our NICU combines medical innovation with a gentle touch. From advanced ventilators to specialized incubators, we provide the latest tools to support each baby's unique needs and promote their healthy development.

### **NICU Level-1**

- Provide a basic level of care to neonates who are at low risk.
- Provide neonatal resuscitation at every delivery.
- Evaluate and provide postnatal care to stable term newborn infants.
- Stabilize and provide care for infants born >35 weeks gestation who remain physiologically stable.
- Stabilize newborn infants who are high risk, establish at the site consultive agreement for timely and safe referral and transport process.

### **NICU Level-2**

 Provide care for infants born ≥32 week's gestation and weighing ≥1500g who have physiological immaturity or who are moderately ill with problems that are expected to resolve rapidly and are not anticipated to need subspecialty services on an urgent basis.

- Provide care for infants convalescing after intensive care.
- Provide mechanical ventilation for brief duration less than 24 hours, CPAP or both.
- Stabilise infants born before 32 weeks and weighing less than 1500g until transfer to NICU.
- Establish at the site consultive agreement for timely and safe referral and transport process for all high risk neonates at level 3 facility.

### **Family-Centered Care**

We understand the importance of family involvement in a baby's care journey. That's why we provide comprehensive support and resources to help parents navigate their NICU experience with confidence and peace of mind.


