
A Minimally Invasive Solution for Hernia: Laparoscopic Surgery



What is a Hernia?

A hernia occurs when an organ or fatty tissue pushes through a weak spot in the surrounding muscle or connective tissue. It can develop in various areas, including the abdomen, groin, or upper thigh. Common types include inguinal, umbilical, hiatal, and incisional hernias.

Who is at Risk?

Certain factors increase the likelihood of developing a hernia, such as:

- Chronic coughing or sneezing
- Heavy lifting or straining
- Obesity or sudden weight gain
- Pregnancy
- Family history of hernias
- Previous abdominal surgery

Treatment Options

Hernias do not heal on their own and often require surgical intervention. The two main approaches to hernia repair are:

Open Surgery – A traditional approach with a larger incision and longer recovery.

Laparoscopic Surgery – A minimally invasive technique using small incisions and a camera for precise repair.

Why Choose Laparoscopic Hernia Surgery?

- Faster recovery time
- Smaller incisions and minimal scarring
- Reduced post-operative pain
- Quicker return to normal activities

Post-Surgery Management

After surgery, proper care is crucial for a smooth recovery. Our specialists recommend:

- Avoiding heavy lifting for a few weeks
- Gradually resuming daily activities
- Following a balanced diet to prevent strain
- Regular follow-ups to monitor healing

Common concerns regarding hernia surgery What is recovery time?

In most cases of laparoscopic hernia repair, patients are up and about, eating normally within 4 hours of surgery. You can go home the same day or next day, and from the time of discharge you can perform all routine functions, and have a normal diet.

What restrictions are there after surgery?

Usually you are back to your normal routine the next day. The only precaution is that you have to take is to avoid lifting heavy weights for about 4 weeks.

What are the risks of surgery for patients with other problems like diabetes, blood pressure or heart disease?

In a planned elective procedure, the surgery is considered low risk even if you have other medical problems. Before surgery all patients are tested thoroughly for any potential problems, and will be reviewed by their cardiologist / physician, and by the anesthesiologist. Any potential additional risks are evaluated and discussed with patients, including the treatment plan.

What are the risks of not getting surgery for hernia?

Patients with hernia run the risk of 2 major complications

- Obstruction: when the intestine pushes out through the hernia and gets stuck, and the intestinal contents cannot pass through
- Strangulation: when the blood supply to the herniated loop of intestine gets cut off leading to tissue death within hours

Both these situations can develop suddenly within hours, and require a major and riskier surgery. Sometimes a portion of the intestine may need to be removed. It is far safer to get the surgery done in a planned manner before these conditions happen.


