Recognizing Illegal Vicodin Websites

Illegal websites use specific tactics to appear legitimate while operating outside all laws.

Absolute red flags for Vicodin sellers:

- Claims of "Rx-free" or "no prescription needed"
- Promises of "VIP health swift arrival" without verification
- No prescription required at any point in checkout

5. Completely different drugs than what was ordered
